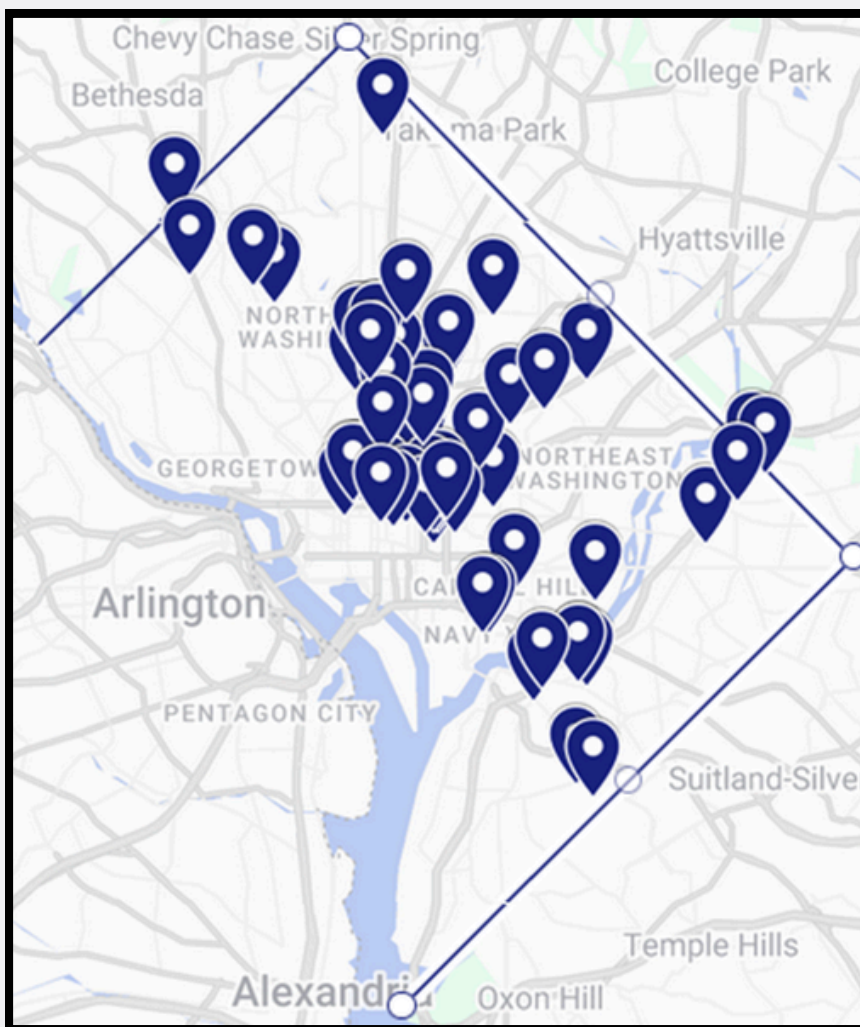


Community Partnerships
